SATURDAY 7TH FEBRUARY

9.30 am. Opening of the festival Marquee in Nueva España Fairground. From 10.00 a.m. onwards, traditional butchering of a pig and preparation of cold meats and delicatessen products: the different sausages including morcilla, salchicha. This year, frying pans of “magra con tomate” (pork meat with tomato sauce) will be cooked.

10.30 am. Official opening of the exhibition “La Fiesta de la Matanza en Alhama”, by the Mayoress Ms. Rosa Sánchez Bishop. Display of instruments, tools and equipment associated with the acts of a matanza, as well as photographs from the last edition of this event.

11.45 am. Live music from the traditional music group “Cantores de Alhama”.

11.55 am. Work begins to prepare a paella with pork meat from the matanza. The winners of several rice cooking competitions, Victoria Andreo and her team, will cook a paella for all attendees.

12.30 pm. Live music from the traditional music group “Taller de Cuerda del Centro de Mayores”.

12.30 pm. Free “salchichas and morcillas” for all to taste (pork sausages and sweet black sausages).

1.00 pm. Live music from the traditional music groups “Músicos de Sonata and Cuadrilla de La Costera”.

2.00 pm. “La Manita Dorada”, official award of recognition to a person or institution who has worked to promote the Fiesta. This year the award goes to Lázaro Portero, who has collaborated and worked to promote this festival from its inception.

1.45 pm. Live music from the folk group “Grupo Folklórico Villa de Alhama”.

2.15 pm. Free samples of magra con tomate (pork meat with tomato sauce) for all to try.

2.30 pm. Free samples of paella for all attendees.

5.30 pm. Live music from the traditional music group “La Edad de Oro”.

6.10 pm. Work begins to prepare migas con tropezones for all, cooked by “el Púas y el Grillo”, with the help of friends.

6.15 pm. Live music from the traditional music group “La Colla del Ramblar”.

7.00 pm. Live music from the traditional music group “Aires de Espuña”.

7.05 pm. Free morcón (white sausage) and sobrasada (a red pork meat paste with sweet paprika and other spices) for all to try.

7.45 pm. Live music from the traditional music group “Los Zalameros”.

8.15 pm. Free migas for all to sample.

8.00 am. Work begins to prepare a giant olla fresca (a pork stew made with rice, beans and pulses)

10.00 am. Workshop for children to make salchichas (pork sausages). Two groups starting at 10 am and 11.30 am. Prior registration required until February 4th in the Concejalía de Festejos (Casa de Cultura).

10.30 am. Display of ham cuttings by the professional David García Romero, with all the ham cut served to attendees.

11.30 pm. Live music from the traditional music group “Finos, Vernas y Rodrejos”.

11.45 pm. Ceremony to officially recognise the businesses collaborating with this edition of the Fiesta de la Matanza.

12.30 pm. Live music from the traditional music group “Cuadrilla de El Berro”.

12.40 pm. Free samples of various delicatessen products to try.

13.00 pm. Delivery of diplomas to the participating children in the “salchichas making” workshop.

13.15 am. Live traditional music from the folk group “Grupo de Coros y Danzas Virgen del Rosario”.

2.15 pm. Free olla fresca for all to try (a rich pork stew, cooked over a period of hours with rice, beans and pulses)

2.30 pm.- Free traditional dessert in the form of paparajotes (a lemon leaf coated in a batter made of flour, egg and lemon zest and then fried and dusted in sugar and cinnamon).
