A walk back through time...

San-Lázaro Bishop Church



Located in the town centre, opposite "Los Patos" garden, this has been a meeting and shopping area since the beginning of the 20th century.



Temple built over an ancient Christian church and rebuilt in the 18th Century, where people worship the "Virgen del Rosario", our patron saint. This Church has been declared a Property of Cultural Interest.



This ancient house. belonging to the Artero family, was built at the beginning of the 20th Century, and restored as the Town Hall in 1986.

It is located in the Constitution Square, in front of La Cubana public park.


